





# HOW TO PROPERLY RESTRAIN YOUR DOG OUTDOORS

**The Safe Outdoor Dogs Act gives owners, animal services personnel and law enforcement easy-to-understand guidelines for restraining dogs outside. Proper restraint under this law means:**



**The dog has access to shelter and drinkable water.**



**Restraints must allow the dog to stand, turn around, and lie down.**



**Prohibits chain restraints which cause injury.**

**Observing proper restraint means protecting your dog and the people around them!**
