




HOW TO PROPERLY RESTRAIN YOUR DOG OUTDOORS

The Safe Outdoor Dogs Act gives owners, animal services personnel and law enforcement easy-to-understand guidelines for restraining dogs outside. Proper restraint under this law means:



The dog has access to shelter and drinkable water.



Restraints must allow the dog to stand, turn around, and lie down.



Prohibits chain restraints which cause injury.

Observing proper restraint means protecting your dog and the people around them!
