
IF RESIDENTS OR PROPERTY OWNERS NEED TO EVACUATE A FLOOD PRONE AREA, THE EVACUATION ROUTE SHOULD AVOID THE FEMA FLOODPLAIN.

THE FEMA FLOODWAY AND FLOODPLAINS ARE INDICATED ON THIS MAP BASED UPON TARRANT COUNTY FEMA FIRM MAP PANELS MOST CURRENT DATA.
