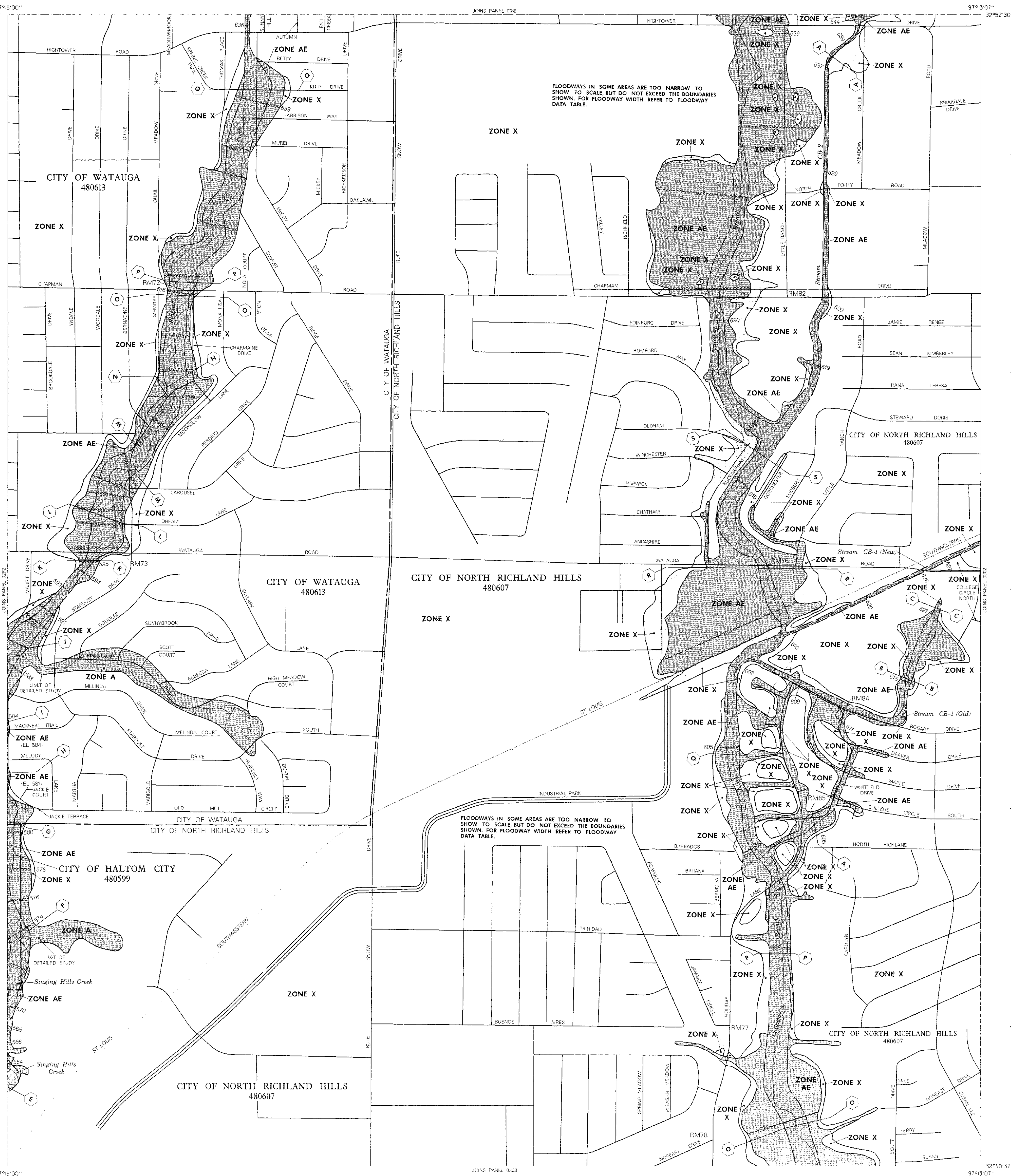

RM72	616.82	Chiseled square on east end of south headwall of culvert on Chapman Road over Singing Hills Creek
RM73	605.42	Railroad spike in power pole located at southwest corner of intersection of Watauga-Smithfield Road and Stardust Drive
RM76	612.29	Chiseled square on top of east end of north headwall of Watauga Road bridge over Calloway Branch, 350 feet west of Little Branch Road
RM77	597.06	Chiseled square on top of west curb of Holiday Lane at intersection of Holiday Lane and Jamaica Circle
RM78	596.26	Chiseled square on top of curb at northwest corner of intersection of Holiday Lane and Nor-East Drive
RM82	626.81	Chiseled square on top of west corner of north headwall of Chapman Drive bridge over Stream CB-2, 250 feet east of Little Branch Road
RM84	610.81	Chiseled square on top of southwest curb of intersection of Bogart Drive and Deaver Drive
RM85	604.18	Chiseled square on top of south end of culvert inlet at northwest corner of the intersection of College Circle South and Whitefield Drive

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local damage sources of small size or all pluvial features subject to Special Flood Hazard Areas.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only to landward of 0.0 NGVD, and include the effects of wave action. These elevations may also differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation planning.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AH, AO, A99, V, and VE.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydrologic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Floodway widths are provided in the Flood Insurance Study Report.

This map may incorporate appropriate modifications of Coastal Barrier Resource System Units and of Determinate Protected Areas established under the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of 1990 (PL 101-581).

Coastal limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.

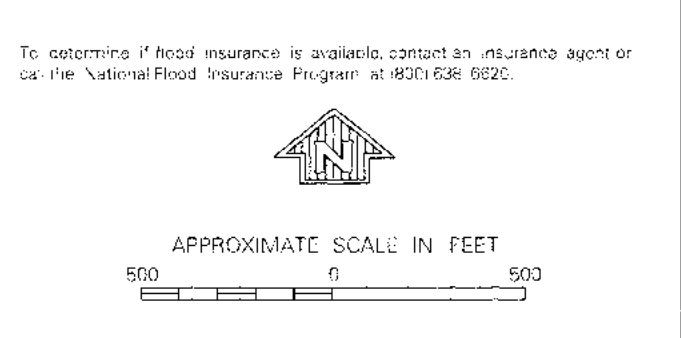
