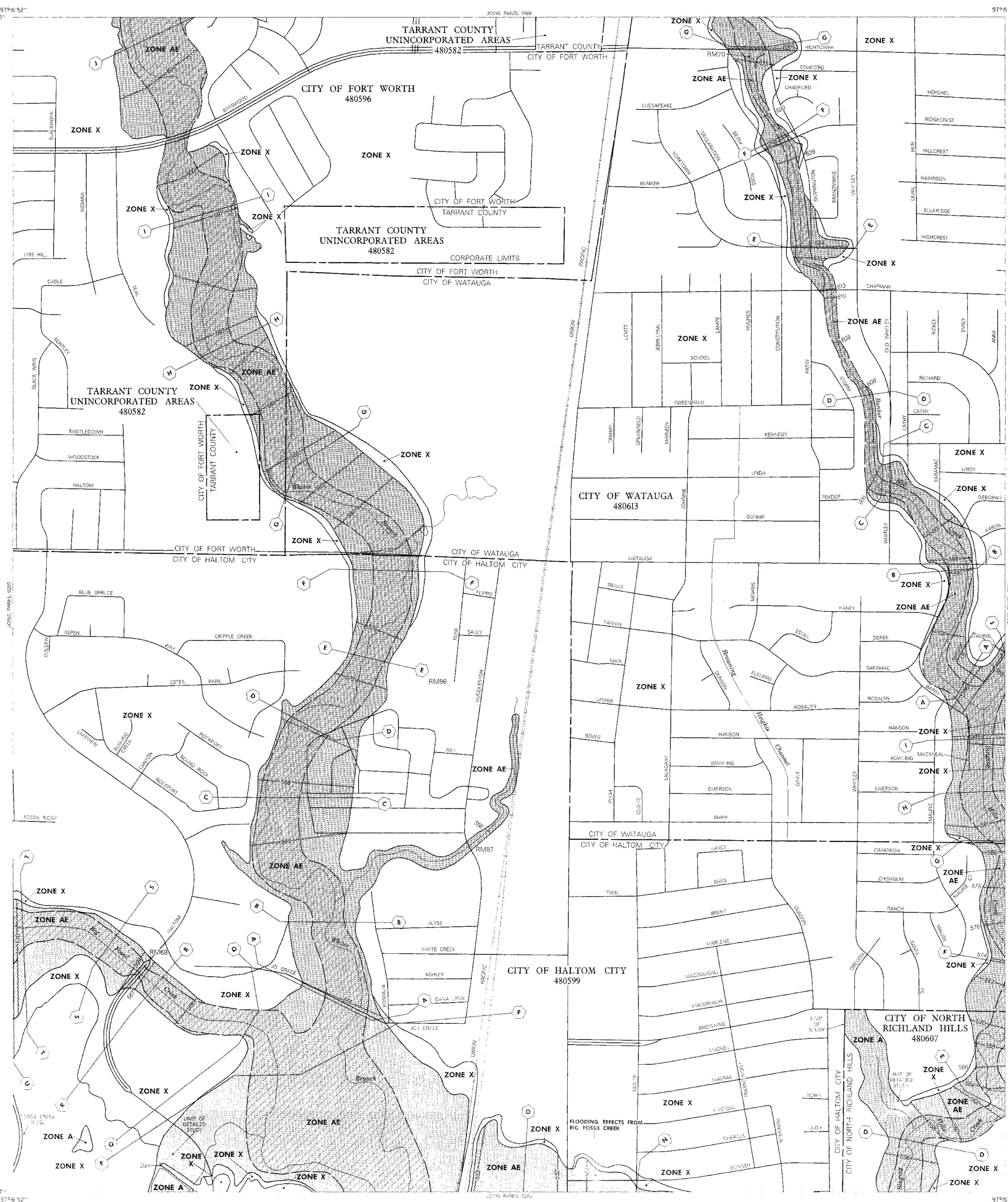


REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION (FEET NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM68	569.37	Painted mark on new Haltom Road bridge over Big Fossil Creek on top of wheel guard at northwest end of the bridge located approximately 700 feet east of northeast end of the new Haltom high school
RM70	435.52	Chiseled square on top of wheel guard on south side of culvert over Bunker Hill Creek on Hightower Road
RM86	416.86	Railroad spike in northeast side of power pole on west side of Rusk Street, 1 block south of Sally Street
RM87	583.47	Chiseled square on southeast corner of west drop inlet located approximately 50 feet south of tributary on Huddleston Street

- ZONE A** No base flood elevations determined.

- ZONE AO** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet usually sheet flow on sloping terrain; average depths determined; for areas of unusual or flooding velocities also determined.
- ZONE A99** To be protected from 100-year flood by Federal flood protection system under construction; no base elevation determined.

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify areas subject to flooding, particularly for local drainage sources of small size, or all parameters; features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only to landward of 500 yards, and include the effects of wave action; these elevations may differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation planning.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AH, AO, A99, V, and VE.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Provable depths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Floodway widths are provided in the Flood Insurance Study Report.

This map may incorporate approximate boundaries of Coastal Barrier Resources, Stream Units and for Other Areas Protection, where established under the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of 1980 (P.L. 96-387).

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community of state to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.
