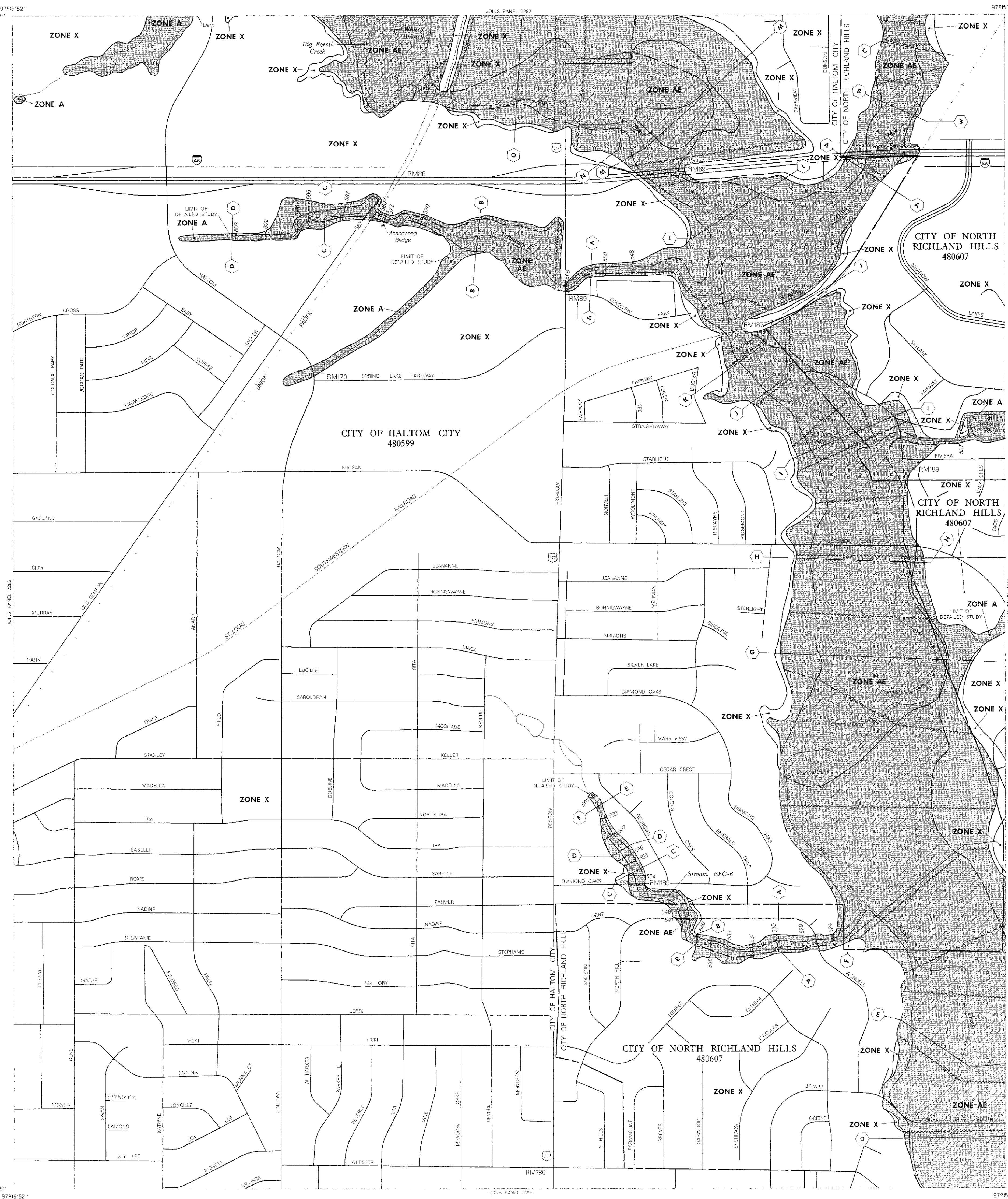

RM69	555.09	Chiseled square on southeast end of eastbound lane of Interstate 820 bridge over Big Fossil Creek on top of wheel guard
RM88	588.97	Chiseled square on east end of south concrete abutment of Union Pacific Railroad overpass over Interstate Route 820
RM89	569.59	Chiseled square on south end of east headwall of 8- by 8-foot box culvert of Tributary 8 under U.S. Route 377
RM170	603.67	Chiseled square on northeast corner of headwall on Hattom Road north of intersection with Spring Lake Parkway
RM186	599.62	Top of a concrete right-of-way marker at southwest corner of intersection of U.S. Route 377 and Webster Road
RM187	563.28	Chiseled square on top of southwest corner of abutment of St. Louis and Southwestern Railroad trestle over Big Fossil Creek
RM188	538.49	On raised lettering of "OO" in spelling of Chattanooga located at southwest corner of Rivera and Circleview Drives
RM189	549.73	Chiseled square on southeast end of culvert on Diamond Oaks Drive over Stream BFC-6, approximately 250 feet west of Georgian Drive

SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS INUNDATED BY 100-YEAR FLOOD

- ZONE A** No base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AE** Base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AH** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet usually areas of parking; base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AO** Flood depths of 3 to 5 feet usually about flow on sloping terrain; average depths determined; for areas of actual fan flooding, velocities also determined.
- ZONE A99** To be protected from upstream flood by Federal flood protection system under construction; no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE V** Coastal flood with velocity hazard wave action; base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE VE** Coastal flood with velocity hazard wave action; base flood elevations determined.

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program; it does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all potential features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only to landward of 0.0 NGVD, and include the effects of wave action; these elevations may also differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation planning.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AH, AO, A99, V, and VE.

Certain areas of Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by local control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Floodway widths are provided in the Flood Insurance Study Report.

This map may incorporate approximate boundaries of Coastal Barrier Resource System Units and/or other barrier-protected areas established under the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of 1982 (P.L. 101-88).

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should consult appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.
