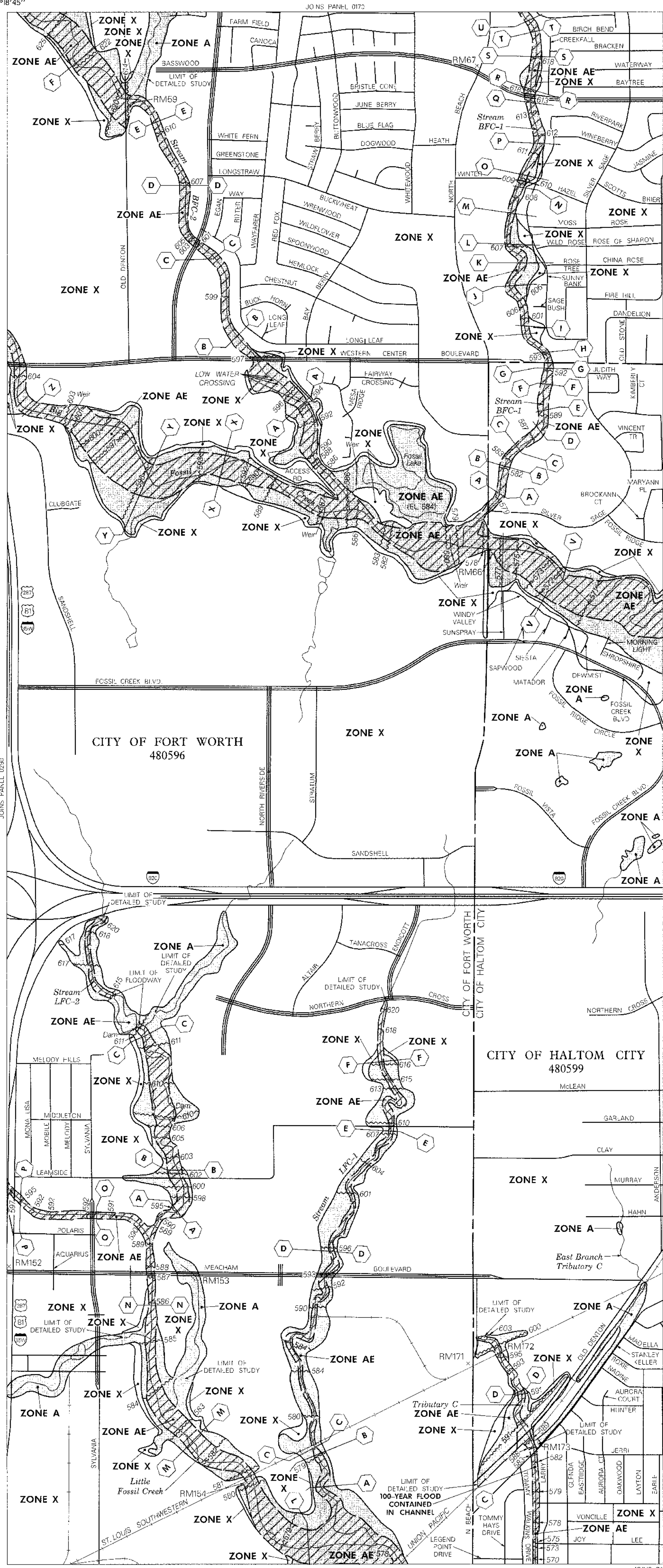

RM59	621.45	WPA brass plate set on top of guardrail, located at southwest corner of bridge on Old Denton Road over Stream BFC-2
RM66	578.49	City monument No. 6603, set in abutment at southwest corner bridge over Big Fossil Creek on North Beach Street, located approximately 0.45 mile south of Worona-Saginaw
RM67	623.85	City monument No. 7916, set at northeast corner of drop inlet, approximately 20 feet west of centerline of North Beach Street, and approximately 75 feet north of centerline of Basswood Boulevard
RM152	605.55	City monument No. 6607, set vertical in most northwest column of bridge on Interstate Route 35W over Meacham Boulevard
RM153	601.49	WPA brass plate No. 13, set in top headwall, located at southwest corner culvert on Meacham Boulevard, and 1.454 feet east of Sylvania Avenue
RM154	589.91	Railroad spike set in crossbeam of first pier, located approximately 2,500 feet east from junction of Sylvania Avenue and St. Louis and Southwestern Railroad, and east of west end of railroad bridge over Little Fossil Creek
RM171	602.92	USC&GS monument No. A-942, set in concrete post located next to TESCO steel high voltage tower along northside of St. Louis and Southwestern Railroad, approximately 99 feet south of northeast corner of tower, approximately 92 feet southeast of southwest corner of steel tower, and approximately 0.5 feet above ground
RM172	599.67	Chiseled square at centerline of old south headwall of St. Louis and Southwestern Railroad on Little Fossil Creek Tributary "C" approximately 400 feet northeast of Beach Street
RM173	590.49	Railroad spike in power pole approximately 50 feet northeast of intersection of Little Lane and Stanley Keller road on north side, approximately 30 feet east of centerline of upstream culverts

LEGEND

SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS INUNDATED BY 100-YEAR FLOOD

- ZONE A** No base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AE** Base flood elevation determined.
- ZONE AH** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually areas of ponding); base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AO** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually sheet flow on sloping terrain); average depths determined; for areas of alluvial fan flooding, velocities also determined.
- ZONE A99** To be protected from 100-year flood by Federal flood protection system under construction; no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE V** Coastal flood with velocity hazard (wave action); no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE VE** Coastal flood with velocity hazard (wave action); base flood elevations determined.

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size or alluvial fans. It is not a substitute for local flood hazard studies. The community map repository should be consulted for more detailed data on EIRs and for any information on floodway elevations prior to use of this map for property purchase or construction purposes.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AH, AO, A99, V, and VE.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to Floodway Data Table where floodway width is shown at 200 feet.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only landward of C.O. NGVD, and include the effects of wave action. These elevations may also differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation planning.

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.

This map may incorporate appropriate boundaries of Coastal Barrier Resource System Units and/or Otherwise Protected Areas established under the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-50).
